

GYAN JYOTI SCHEME (GUIDELINES)

An initiative of Chief Minister of Assam for Educational Development of Students of Assam.

The city of Guwahati is enriched with various premier educational, Cultural and religious Institution. The students of Rural areas of the other Districts of Assam are completely unaware about them. To give them exposure of all these Institution Chief Minister of Assam has taken an initiative.

Through this initiative 7500 nos. of students from the Rural areas will be offered to visit Guwahati every year during the summer/winter vacation of the school in order to provide them exposure to these institutions. This exposure will help in their carrier planning and will also inculcate competitiveness amongst them. Government of Assam will bear all the expenses of the students including the transportation cost.

1. ELIGIBILITY

- (a) From each of the district of Assam 10 high Schools located in the rural areas will be identified by the Deputy Commissioners of the District for this scheme.
- (b) From each school number of participants will have to be selected by the school from Class- VIII to X.
- (c) While selecting the participants the school will have to select minimum 2 participants for taking part in quiz competition, 2 participants for taking part in debate competition and 2 participants for cultural events.
- (d) During Summer vacation 5 schools and during winter vacation 5 schools for each district will be selected for this purpose.

2. FACILITIES

- (a) Free transport facility will be provided to them for visiting Guwahati and the entire trip will be of 2 days duration.
 - (b) In Guwahati they will be provided facility for sightseeing at the following places.
Sri Sri sankardeva Kalakheta, Zoo, Museum, Planetarium, Balaji Mandir, ISBT, Guwahati University, Cotton College, IIT and other important places.
 - (c) On an average per day 300 students will be accommodated at Guwahati during winter vacation and summer vacation.
3. During their stay at Guwahati Quiz Competition, debate Competition & cultural Competition will be arranged amongst the students.
 4. While their visit to Cotton College, Guwahati University and IIT, lectures will be delivered to them by the experienced lectures about their Carrier Planning.
 5. Govt. of Assam will incur an expenditure of Rs.1200.00 per student.

Total expenditure will be 7500 X 1200-90,00,000.00 per year.
